Introducing "Breakfast Church"

September isn't far off, and with it the start of new seasons. A new school year begins, football teams and marching bands head back onto the field, and we enter autumn. This September will also mark the start of a new season for St. Francis. A season of mission, where we focus our efforts on proclaiming by word and example the Good News of God in Christ to those outside our normal circle.

One way we will do this is by starting a new Sunday morning service, *Breakfast Church*. *Breakfast Church* is an avenue for us to invite our neighbors into a welcoming and accessible environment for busy families to worship alongside their children.

Breakfast Church draws on our Episcopal tradition to craft a new way of worshipping and being church. All are invited to a joyful, warm and engaging 30-minute Episcopal church service designed for children of all ages and their families, but open to anyone of any age. We will meet Sunday mornings at 9ish in the Commons to praise and worship God over breakfast. This liturgy (worship) is a service geared with families in mind, so come as you are in soccer uniforms or even pajamas to sing, share, and eat with us. Together we will express and encounter the deep truths of the Christian faith in language and action accessible to everyone, including scripture, a short conversational sermon, interactive communion and music both traditional and new.

The commons give us plenty of room for young ones to run and play in this perfection free zone. A generous breakfast of cereal, milk, bagels and fruit will be provided, including vegan and gluten free options, or bring your favorite cereal to share.

Breakfast Church launches on Sunday, September 12 with a special sneak preview for the St. Francis parish on Sunday, September 5th, when we will practice this worship during the 10:30 am service in place of our normal liturgy. September 5th will be a great chance for everyone at St. Francis to experience and understand the new service we are launching.




A Service of Prayer & Remembrance



The Rt. Reverend George Wayne Smith Elected as Provisional Bishop

The Rt. Rev. George Wayne Smith was elected as Provisional Bishop of the Diocese of Southern Ohio during a special session of the 146th convention (virtual) on July 17, 2021. Smith was placed in nomination for Provisional Bishop by the Standing Committee on June 8, 2021, and the special session of the convention was called on June 10, 2021. He was elected on the first ballot of both the lay and clergy orders. See the results

Smith was elected Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese of Missouri in 2001 and ordained bishop in 2002. Later that year he was seated as the Tenth Bishop of the Diocese, where he served until 2020. He will begin his duties as Provisional Bishop on August 15, 2021.
